

NUNAVUT PLANNING COMMISSION NOTICE OF RESPONSES TO SUBMISSIONS ON THE DRAFT NUNAVUT LAND USE PLAN, 2016 AND REQUESTS FOR EXTENSION

Date: January 31, 2019

On July 16, 2018 the Nunavut Planning Commission reopened the record to allow participants to submit additional written representations and evidence relating to the Draft Nunavut Land Use Plan, 2016 and on December 6, 2018 an opportunity to respond to those written submissions was provided until January 25, 2019. As of January 25, 2019 the NPC has received responses from the following participants:

- 1. Nunavut Tunngavik Inc
- 2. Qikiqtani Inuit Association
- 3. Government of Canada
- 4. Government of Nunavut
- 5. Beverly and Qamanirjuag Caribou Management Board

In addition, on January 15, 2019, the Qikiqtaaluk Wildlife Board (QWB) notified the Commission that it has not released digital shapefiles associated with its November 2018 submissions due to a lack of data sharing protocols, and because of this NTI and QIA have requested that the Commission extend the opportunity to respond to the November 2018 submissions. The Commissioners will, when they meet March 14-18, 2019, consider whether to accept late submissions.
