Caribou Protected Areas

We support **Protected Area** designation
(Option 1) for the **Core Calving Grounds,**
Post Calving Grounds, Freshwater Crossings,
and **Key Access Corridors**



Caribou Protected Areas

We support **Special Management Area** designation (Option 2) for the **Rutting Area** and **Migration Corridors**.



Caribou Mobile Protection

We do **not** support the Mobile Protection Measures because:

1. NLUP can be reviewed periodically
2. We don't know what it does
3. We cannot wait until causal relationship is established



Grandfathering

We endorse the Ecojustice submission on August 29, 2016 on this issue.
