This document describes the results of a two year initiative carried out by the GN to identify the specific geographic areas or hot spots within Nunavut that, from a GN perspective, would require special management in the Nunavut Land Use Plan. This package of materials (one all season map, six seasonal maps, and the summary report) was prepared in anticipation of the formal “structured process” for clarifying expectations as per the recommendations made in the *Independent Review of the Draft Nunavut Land Use Plan- Final Report, section 8.2.3*

These maps were designed as a tool to target specific areas for further investigation through the land use planning process. It is the GN's hope that the NPC may be able to assimilate the priorities of other stakeholders, thereby broadening the scope of the project beyond the perspective of the GN.

Following receipt of this letter, I would be pleased to have my staff to travel to Cambridge Bay and deliver the project materials (one all season map and six seasonal maps) to the NPC's planning staff in person. Please have your staff contact mine to arrange an appropriate time.
