The Nunavut Planning Commission is established under the Nunavut Land Claims Agreement to prepare a land use plan for Nunavut. The Plan will have rules that can protect the land, water, wildlife and hunting areas important to Inuit. The Plan will also provide for a broad range of economic opportunities.

Government has shown us the areas they think are important for wildlife. This information is contained in the attached Wildlife Habitat Report. The places where development is occurring in Nunavut today are shown in the attached Socio-demographic and Economic Sector Analysis Report. We have taken all the information in the two reports and created a series of maps to help you see what is happening in Nunavut. There are some problems with the Inuktitut translations on our maps. We apologize for this and we will have those fixed shortly. Our website at nunavut.ca will allow you to create your own maps for the area around your community.

We know that all of Nunavut is important to wildlife and Inuit. We also know that jobs and a strong business sector are important too. We have heard that the Inuit of some communities are interested in protecting special places from development. We have heard from others that there is no interest in protecting lands at this time.


