- **are important to your community for hunting , fishing, camping as much of the harvest comes from those areas.**


Every Story Needs to be Told

If you already have this information on maps, we would like to work with you to receive the information so that the Commission can take into account your interest regarding the areas that you have traditionally used and continue to use.

We would like to receive this information by the end of June, 2009 so that it may be included in the next phase of the plan development process.
