Some of the key issues in the 2016 Draft Nunavut Land Use Plan to be discussed

- Your views on how the 2016 Draft Plan proposed to manage land use in important areas such as:
 - Caribou calving areas, post-calving areas, freshwater crossings, and sea ice crossings
 - Key migratory bird habitat sites near your community
 - Community on-ice travel routes
 - Boothia Peninsula Area of Interest
- Should some uses not be allowed in these areas, or are there other ways that they can be managed?
- Have the areas been identified correctly?
- How economic opportunities including existing mineral rights and proposed roads could be affected by the land use plan.
- Are there other areas so important to your community that the land use plan should tell others how they should be used?
