Re. Blue Star Gold Corp. Additional Written Submission: 2021 Draft Nunavut Land Use Plan

Blue Star Gold Corp. (Blue Star) and its wholly-owned subsidiaries Inukshuk Exploration Incorporated and Ulu Mining Inc. (collectively referred to herein as Blue Star), operate mineral properties in the Kitikmeot Region. Blue Star is the largest mineral titleholder on the High Lake Greenstone Belt; this geological formation runs the length of the northern half of the proposed Grays Bay Road.

Since its prior submission regarding the 2021 Draft Nunavut Land Use Plan (DNLUP) made in October 2021, Blue Star has acquired additional Crown and Inuit Owned mineral tenure in relation to its Roma and Hood River projects and is providing this letter to supplement the information provided previously to ensure its existing rights are adequately considered in land use planning. Accordingly, an updated summary of its existing rights is provided Table 1.
