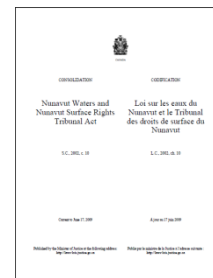

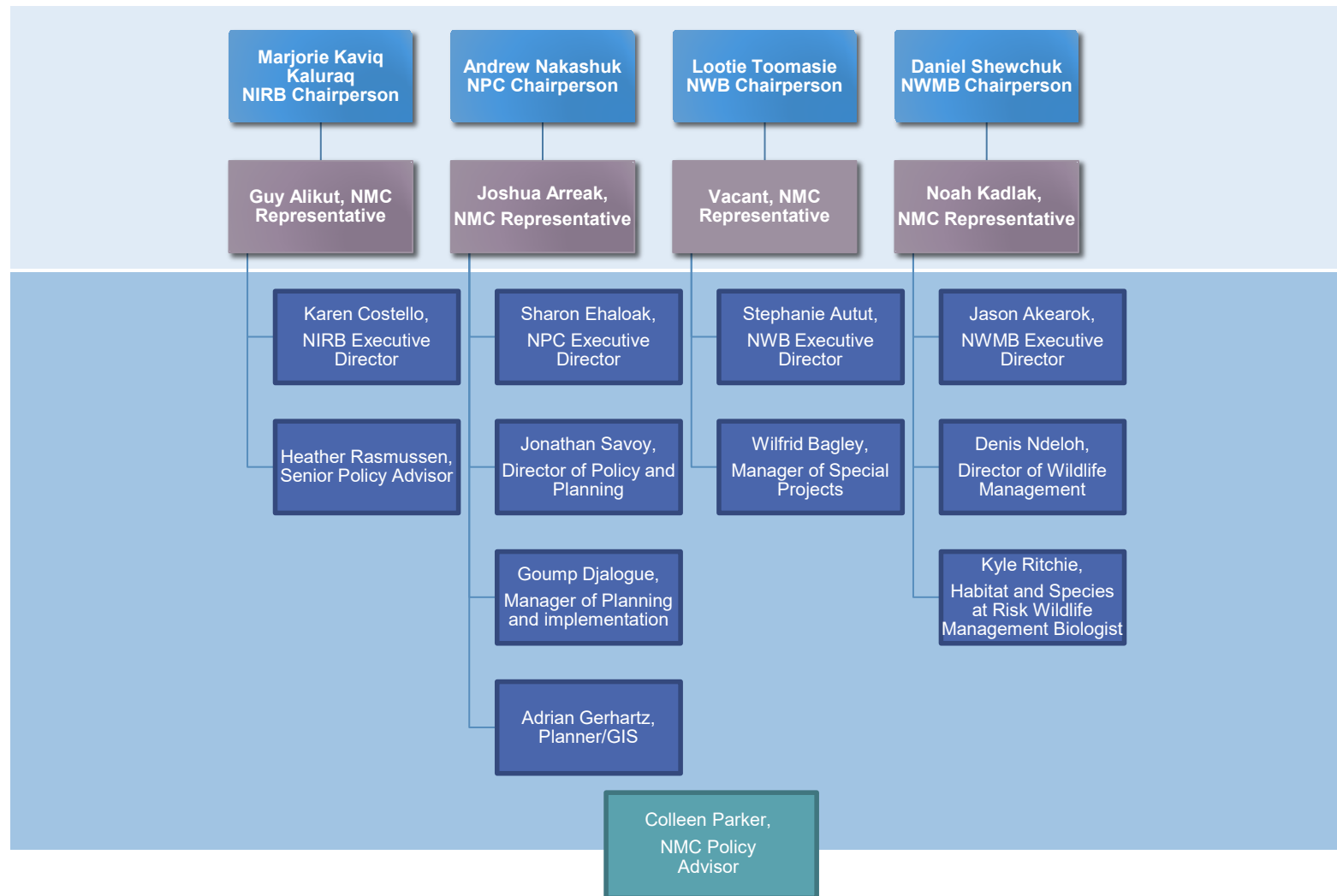

- The NMC is acting as an observer in the the NLUP process in order to inform recommendations and advice to government agencies about non-project shipping, which is outside the scope of the NLUP.
- The NMC's potential recommendations and advice are very broad, relating to the marine environment in Nunavut, and are informed by the information shared in the individual IPGs' processes, including these public hearings.
