- All kinds of ducks migrate and lay eggs
- All kinds of geese migrate and lay eggs
- All kinds of loons migrate and lay eggs
- All kind of sea birds migrate and lay eggs
- All types of birds live in Boothia
- Foxes have dens
- Wolves have dens
- Polar Bears have dens
- Belugas and Narwhales come up to the shores to feed
- All types of Seals come up to the shores to feed
- All the animal that live and migrate in and on Boothia Peninsula is our ego-system and we want to protect the land and its resources for generations to come.
