

Introduction


- * The Baffinland Mary River Mine has been in operation for three years
- * To continue to provide benefits to the communities Baffinland must increase production and lower costs
- * To accomplish this a railway must be constructed within the existing Transportation Corridor

The Proposed Amendment

- The NBRLUP already has an existing Transportation Corridor but it does not specifically reference rail transportation
 - * The proposed amendment would make it clear that rail can be considered in the existing Corridor
 - then the NIRB can proceed with the environmental assessment of the proposed Project
