



## NUNAVUT PLANNING COMMISSION NOTICE OF OPPORTUNITY TO RESPOND TO WRITTEN SUBMISSIONS ON THE DRAFT NUNAVUT LAND USE PLAN, 2016

Date: December 6, 2018

On July 16, 2018 the Nunavut Planning Commission reopened the record to allow participants to submit additional written representations and evidence relating to the Draft Nunavut Land Use Plan, 2016 and an extension was later granted until November 26, 2018. As of November 29, 2018 the NPC has received additional written submissions from the following participants:
