Re: Nunavut Tunngavik Incorporated response to Government of Canada Priority Expectations for a First Generation Nunavut Land Use Plan

Dear James,

On July 3, 2013 the Nunavut Planning Commission requested that Nunavut Tunngavik Incorporated (NTI) provide details to its May 21, 2013 submission noted above. In that submission NTI states that the Commission's community consultation process is not "well developed" and that this concern needs to be addressed. To date we have not received a response to our request for details.

The Independent Third Party Review (ITPR) our organizations commissioned in partnership with government clarifies NPC's mandate under the Nunavut Land Claims Agreement as it relates to the consultation process. For reference the ITPR states that, "Developing and implementing the public and stakeholder participation strategy (including determining what is appropriate) are clearly within the NPC's mandate."

Community Consultations are starting in the Kivalliq Region October 31, 2013. We are proceeding with the consultations and it is the Commissions hope that any concerns NTI may have had with the land use planning process have been resolved. The Commission recognizes the NTI commitment to the process with the attendance of your staff member at all community consultation sessions.

Thank you for your continued support and participation in the land use planning process.
