



## NUNAVUT PLANNING COMMISSION

### NOTICE OF EXTENDED OPPORTUNITY TO RESPOND TO WRITTEN SUBMISSIONS ON THE DRAFT NUNAVUT LAND USE PLAN, 2016

Date: March 18, 2019

On July 16, 2018 the Nunavut Planning Commission reopened the record to allow participants to submit additional written representations and evidence relating to the Draft Nunavut Land Use Plan, 2016 and an extension was later granted until November 26, 2018. As of November 29, 2018 the NPC received additional written submissions from the following participants:

1. Qikiqtaaluk Wildlife Board (with participation from 13 Hunters and Trappers Organizations)
2. Baker Lake HTO
3. Taloyoak (Spence Bay) HTO
4. NWT & Nunavut Chamber of Mines

Participants were then able to respond to the additional written submissions by January 25, 2019; however, on January 15, 2019, the Qikiqtaaluk Wildlife Board (QWB) notified the Commission that it has not released digital shapefiles associated with its November 2018 submissions due to a lack of data sharing protocols, and because of this NTI and QIA requested that the Commission extend the opportunity to respond to the November 2018 submissions. On March 15, 2019 the Commission met and determined that it will accept and consider responses from participants to the above noted written submissions until 12:00 PM (noon) Eastern time on May 17, 2019.
