## RE: The Designation of Department of National Defence Sites in the Draft Nunavut Land Use Plan

The Nunavut Planning Commission (NPC) appreciates the active engagement of the Department of National Defence in the development of the draft Nunavut Land Use Plan (NLUP).

In a letter dated May 8, 2014, DND indicated that the proposed Special Management Area land use designations for DND sites in the June 2014 Draft Nunavut Land Use Plan are overly restrictive, and reiterated the need for Radome Setback Zones and Aerodrome Safety Zones to be included in the plan. The NPC is committed to managing land use in and around DND sites through the NLUP to ensure their objectives continue to be met, and we would like to discuss with you in greater detail how the plan can best support the continued use of DND sites.
