PROJECT TITLE: New Temporary Operational Camp at Dundee Bight + extension for using Dome Camp as a secondary camp

## PROJECT LOCATION:

Qausuittuq National Park (Dundee Bight: N 75°52.012' / W 099°53.011') Qausuittuq National Park (Dome Camp: N 75°48.168' / W 101°17.489')

## PROJECT DATES:

Delivery of fuel + construction material (Dundee Bight): April 2021 Camp construction (Dundee Bight): July 2021 Use of temporary camps (Dome Camp + Dundee Bight): 2021-2025

## PROJECT DESCRIPTION:

A temporary operational camp (Dome Camp) was installed in 2016 in order to support a variety of activities and projects within the boundaries of Qausuittuq National Park, while providing safety for staff and users, especially from polar bears. The duration of that project was initially estimated to 3 years, after what a more permanent camp would be considered. However, Dome Camp's location ended up not being appropriate for most operational activities, especially for aircraft access (strong cross winds, mud, etc.). Here, we propose a new location (Dundee Bight) for installing the main operational camp while keeping Dome Camp in use as a secondary camp.

The new camp will have two hard-sided shelters installed on platforms (16'X18'), one of which will be constructed in 2021 and the other in 2022.
