

## NUNAVUT PLANNING COMMISSION NOTICE OF REOPENING OF RECORD AND NEXT STEPS FOR THE 2021 DRAFT NUNAVUT LAND USE PLAN

Date: July 23, 2021

On July 8, 2021 the Nunavut Planning Commission released a revised 2021 Draft Nunavut Land Use Plan (DNLUP) and supporting Options and Recommendations document.

On July 21, 2021 the Commission met and reopened the record for submissions on the 2021 DNLUP. Written submissions on the 2021 DNLUP are requested to be filed by September 30, 2021. All responses can be submitted by email at <a href="mailto:submissions@nunavut.ca">submissions@nunavut.ca</a>, by fax at 867-979-3443, or by mail at Box 1797, Iqaluit, Nunavut X0A 0H0. Participants with capacity are encouraged to provide translated copies of their submissions.

Participants who were registered as part of the review of the 2016 DNLUP are identified in Appendix A of this notice and remain participants. Participants are encouraged to review the primary contact included in Appendix A and advise the Commission if it needs to be updated. Interested parties not included in this list can register as participants by completing Form 1 of the Commission's *Rules for Public Proceedings*, attached as Appendix B to this Notice, by September 30th.

Regional public hearings on the 2021 DNLUP will be held in Rankin Inlet on November 1-5, 2021 for the Kivalliq Region and Denesuline and in Cambridge Bay on November 23-26, 2021 for the Kitikmeot Region. Please note, in the event weather delays the start of the hearing, it may be extended beyond the ending dates noted above. Five representatives will be chosen by each community to participate at the hearings.

The Commission plans additional hearings to be held in Pond Inlet and Iqaluit **subject to the availability of funding**. Participants can attend any of the regional hearings in person or virtually and are asked to confirm which hearing(s) they will attend by September 30, 2021, and must provide copies of their presentations, and questions to the Commission or other participants by October 20, 2021.

Participants will be able to provide responses to submissions, additional comments, or further responses to questions within 40 days following the last hearing. Agendas for the regional public hearings will be distributed to participants in advance for comment.

Participants are advised that the Commission intends to further revise the DNLUP in consideration of written submissions and feedback from the regional public hearings and submit a recommended plan for approval to the Government of Canada, the Government of Nunavut and Nunavut Tunngavik Inc. in 2022.
