I: CONDITIONS APPLYING TO ABANDONMENT, RECLAMATION AND

ON April 11, 2019 The Nunavut Water Board Issued 8WLC-CBA1920 to Queen University's Department of Geography and Planning MC D201 SCOTT LAMOUREAUX for an undertaking carried under the Cape Bounty Arctic Watershed Observatory Project.

The Cape Bounty Arctic Watershed Observatory (CBAWO) Project, located at Cape Bounty, Melville Island, approximately 430 km west of Resolute and 660 km north of Cambridge Bay, within the Qikiqtani Region, Nunavut and within the Melville Island Watershed (54), generally at the following geographical coordinates: N74° 54 08.6 W109 36 02.0.

The old camp situated at N74 54 00.0 W109 35 00.0 used during the issuance of 3BC-CBA10115 can be closed as an aerial survey of the site didn't reveal any non-compliance issues.

Inspector Statement

On July 7, 2019at 5:40pm, A Water Licence Inspection was by Water Resource Officers (WRO) Joseph Monteith, Erik Allain, and Jeremy Fraser at Melville Island, Qikiqtani Region, Nunavut, for water licence 8WLC-CBA1920. Scott Lamoureux welcomed the inspectors and escorted them on the site inspection. The inspection was complete on July 7, 2019 at 5:40pm.

Water Supply Facilities

- 1. The water source is a stream from two small lakes 4 kilometres (km) meanders downgrade west to south of the camp to a lake which eventually drains out 1.6km towards the ocean at Cape Bounty. No alterations to the bed or banks of a water course were observed.
- 2. Water withdrawal records were recorded in a log book and observed on site (photo). The log book recorded





between the dates of May 31, 2019 and July 7, 2019 a total of 845 litres.

Waste

- 3. Sump pit observed on site. The sump pit was very small and clearly marked and more than 31 metres away from any water body.
- 4. Grey water discharge levels measured and recorded in log book and observed onsite (photo). Log Book records indicate that between the dates of May 31, 2019 and July 7, 2019 a total of 316 litres of grey water deposited into the sump pit(photo)
- 5. No latrine observed on site
- 6. No sign of fire pits

Fuel Cache

- 7. 2 fuel caches observed on site (photo 5&6).
- 8. Total count of fuel was 1 drum of gasoline, 5 jerry cans of gasoline, and 13 cylinders of propane.

Vehicles

9. A snowmobile, and all-terrain vehicle (atv), and a rubber boat were observed on site.




