The following works and activities have been proposed in the above-noted project proposal:

1. Application for NWB authorization for use or deposit of water without a licence for a temporary pressure-washing station in Iqaluit. The estimated water use is a maximum of 20m3 cubic meters /day. Potential water sources include Dead Dog Lake and a creek going into the ocean on West-40 Road.

The Nunavut Planning Commission (NPC) has determined that this project proposal is outside the area of an applicable regional land use plan and is exempt from screening by the Nunavut Impact Review Board (NIRB). The

project proposal does not require screening because it belongs to a class of works or activities set out in Schedule 12-1 of the Nunavut Agreement (NA), and the NPC does not have concerns regarding the cumulative impacts of the project proposal.
