



NUNAVUT PLANNING COMMISSION NOTICE OF ADDITIONAL COMMENTS AND QUESTIONAL RECEIVED ON THE 2021 DRAFT NUNAVUT LAND USE PLAN

On May 4, 2022 the Nunavut Planning Commission (NPC or Commission) requested that participants submit additional and/or supplementary written submissions with a list of the questions they would like to ask the Commission or other participants regarding the 2021 DNLUP in advance of the regional public hearings scheduled to take place in September through November 2022. On or before June 24, 2022 the NPC received additional written submissions and questions from the following participants:

The Commission appreciates all the participants who were able to provide supplementary written submissions and questions to the NPC during this round of comment requests. The NPC has completed its review of all the written submissions received and has determined that most of the comments and questions received were specifically directed to the Commission. In order to address the series of technical comments raised on the 2021 DNLUP and limit the number of outstanding technical issues to be brought forward to the public hearings, the NPC will be responding to all the relevant questions on or before **August 30, 2022**. Furthermore, where multiple parties have asked the same or similar questions, the NPC will endeavor to provide one response that will adequately address those questions to avoid unnecessary duplication.

The Commission respectfully requests that all participants review all the questions and submissions as available via the NPC's online public registry and supply the NPC with any additional questions they wish to be addressed prior to the Public Hearings, on or before August 30, 2022.
